The Institute has definite Bylaw provisions for false information furnished on the application for admission or transfer in grade, as quoted below:

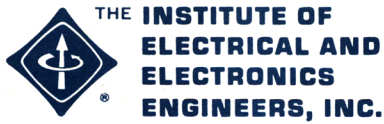
"If information is presented to the Executive Committee indicating that the applicant for membership or transfer to a higher grade has been elected on the basis of an application containing apparent misrepresentations or false statements, the Executive Committee shall investigate and provide the member an opportunity to submit an explanation. If the Executive Committee concludes that such membership was obtained through misrepresentation or false statements, the membership shall be terminated with notice mailed to the member."

There is no specific Bylaw covering the case you describe. I feel each such case would be handled on an individual basis with whatever supporting information a Section, individual, etc., can furnish to IEEE.

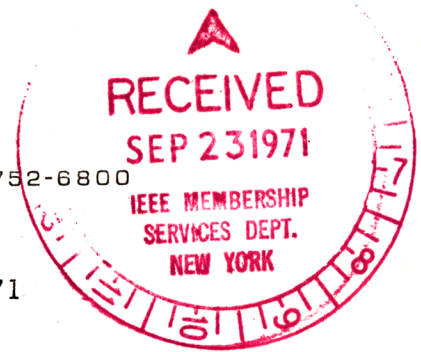

Dear Mr. Hogg:

Some weeks ago IEEE Director Bill Thompson brought to my attention your letter of May 20, 1971 to him concerning the unauthorized use of IEEE credentials by a person whose membership had lapsed in 1965.

As Emily Sirjane has informed you, there is no stated Bylaw provision for handling such cases. However, if there is a flagrant case of misrepresentation involved, we can take action in the form of a letter to the individual concerned, stating that his activities are not authorized asking him to be governed accordingly.

This letter is to ask your advice on our course of action. If the misrepresentation continues, to your knowledge, I would appreciate your sending me, in confidence, as much information as possible so that we can take action.

Cases of this type are extremely infrequent, so much so that I cannot recall a similar instance since the founding of IEEE in 1963. Our lawyers advise that it is probably not feasible for us to control a situation like this, particularly outside the United States, by direct legal action.

We are, of course, very anxious to protect the good name of IEEE in every way we can. I much appreciate your bringing the situation to our attention and would appreciate your advice.

Dear Bill:

We received the article from Mr. Cook in fine shape and it is now being printed in the NEWSLETTER. Many thanks for that Bill, - that article just fits in perfectly with our final speaker of the year - the manager of our local Cable TV system. As always it was a pleasure to see you again, in Waterloo.

There was a subject of a rather unpleasant nature which I had intended to speak to you on but the opportunity did not arise. What it involved was this - we have in our section a gentleman who has been claiming membership in the IEEE as one of his few accreditations for his teaching position at the local Community College and I have reason to believe he represented himself as a member when applying for his present position as well. This year this chap is still claiming membership even though I spoke personally to him last fall on this matter. He stated that his membership had just lapsed and when asked directly he stated that it had lapsed 2 years prior and that he felt there was no problem at all since all he had to do was to send in his dues and he would be a full member again.

I checked with Emily Sirjane and she informed me he had been a member and his membership had lapsed in December of 1965. I feel that he has no interest in the IEEE (as he has indicated in conversations) but is still willing to use his 'affiliation' for all its worth. Why am I writing? - The man is teaching at Conestoga College as well, and it was through this relationship that I learned of the situation. This is the first time I have run across an individual who operates in this highly unprofessional manner and would like to know:

- a) Have you run across this before?
- b) What course of action would you suggest since he is well aware of what he is doing?

Emily has indicated that there is nothing in the bylaws to cover this situation.

Let me end on a pleasant note by wishing you all the best.

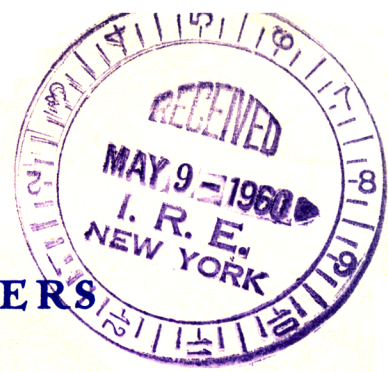

Dear Mr. Barclay:

For some time now, the Kitchener-Waterloo Sub-Section of the Institute of Radio Engineers has been planning to attain full Section status.

We require this for several reasons. We hope that by becoming a Section, we can speed our communications directly to IRE Headquarters. The matter of financing is much simplified also, since we would be able to receive direct reimbursement from Headquarters. As you will probably know, at present we must operate through Hamilton Section; this at times can become time consuming insofar as communication is concerned.

The paperwork required to maintain the Section is certainly simplified through the elimination of original and carbon copies of letters to the executive of the Mother Section. However, we realize that by becoming a Section, in no way means that we will sever completely our bonds with any Section. We have, in fact, maintained the closest relationships with Hamilton, Toronto, and London Sections. Our Joint Reactor Meeting of April 14 is a good example of what inter-section co-operation can accomplish.

I am enclosing herewith the following documents:

- (1) A petition signed by 29 senior members, members, and associates of our Sub-Section.
- (2) A signed release of Perth and Bruce Counties from London Section to the proposed Kitchener-Waterloo Section. This action, we felt was necessary to "round out" our area, and was transferred voluntarily by the London Section.
- (3) An outline drawing of the boundaries of the proposed Kitchener-Waterloo Section.

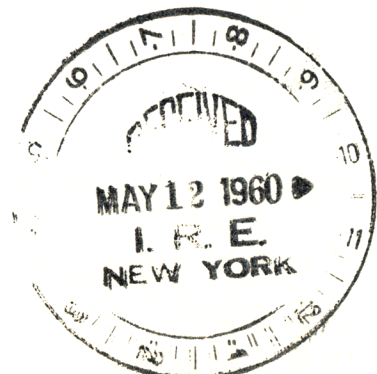

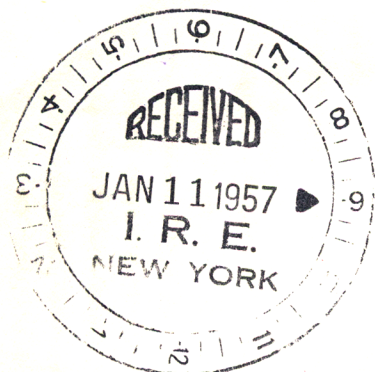

I have received copy of your petition to IRE regarding the organization of a Kitchener - Waterloo Sub-Section and it is certainly pleasing to see interest in IRE in such a busy electronic section as Waterloo and Kitchener.

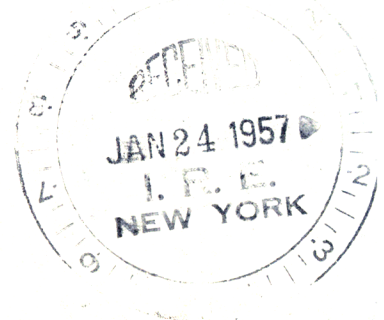
In connection with the organization of this sub-section there are however, some complications which must be ironed out, in order to get boundaries properly established. Miss Sirjane in New York has been very helpful in trying to interpret the boundaries you had in mind, which must be stated in terms of counties rather than cities. Unfortunately you have included the cities of Stratford and Wingham, the first being in the County of Perth, and the second in Huron County, both of which are in the London Section.

In order to include Perth and Huron Counties, the London Section will have to agree in writing and this change (to section territory) can only be arranged with the sanction of the Board of Directors in New York.

The Counties of Harton, Wellington and Waterloo are within the Hamilton Section boundaries and they have already agreed to your forming this Sub-Section with the consequent loss of these Counties, and since a Section can agree to the formation of a Sub-Section in its territory, this action can be ratified by the Executive Committee in New York, which meets on February 8th.

In view of the above, we would suggest that you immediately re-submit your petition to Headquarters, naming only the Counties of Harton, Wellington and Waterloo, in order that the Kitchener-Waterloo Sub-Section can come into being by Executive Committee action at their February 8th Meeting or possibly their March Meeting, if you cannot arrange it in time.
