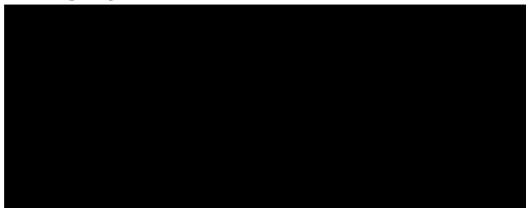

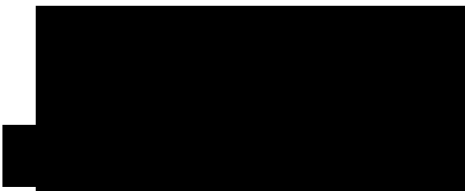

If you require any further information from us please feel free to ask for it.

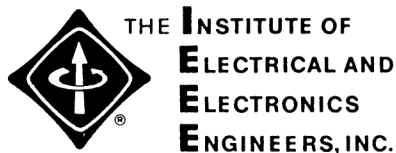

I have for reference your letter of February 7 addressed to Mr Mark Lucas of IEEE, and his letter of February 21 addressed to you.

I am pleased to note that you have made excellent progress with regard to the proposal to elevate Karachi sub-section to section status. As indicated by Mr Lucas, your petition contains only about 45 valid signatures. I would request you to kindly obtain signatures of another 5 or 6 existing members (excluding student members) from Karachi area. These could also include the signatures of new members you are enlisting in Karachi area provided their application has already been sent to the IEEE. I am hoping that you could do this by April 1982 so that I may propose to the May meeting of the IEEE Regional Activities Board that your sub-section be elevated to Section status.

In the above context I may also mention that the proposal to elevate your sub-section to Section status requires the concurrence of Pakistan Section. I would be grateful if you can take this subject up with Mr Mian Saleem Hasan, Chairman of IEEE Pakistan Section and see that a relevant resolution from the Section Executive Committee is sent to IEEE with copy to me.

I wish your Section a very speedy support. I am hoping that we will have all relevant formalities completed within the next three or four months. We could then plan for IEEE 1982 President Dr Robert Larson to inaugurate your Section during his visit to Pakistan during August 17-19, 1982.

Thank you for your letter and petition forms dated February 7. We have reviewed the signatures and found that approximately nine (9) signatures could not be counted as valid for the petition. Most of these were student members whose signatures are not valid on petitions of this sort. Two of the members, Mr. Parvez Ali and Mr. Sabzwari currently have their dues expired and are not qualified to sign the petition.

However, I have brought this situation to the attention of Mr. Don Suppers the Staff Director of Field Services, and I believe he will discuss it with Regional Director Kodali at the RAB meeting in Washington, DC this week. Although it is not on the agenda for the meeting, it is possible that RAB might waive the 50 signatures required and act upon the request for Section status. Since I do not have written indication that the Pakistan Section supports this change in status, the proceeding may be a bit delayed, unless Dr. Kodali has this information as well.

At any rate, I do not see serious difficulty at this point in the upgrading of Karachi to Section status and will be interested to see any results from the meeting this week. We will keep you informed of the progress.
