ARTICLE 4 - MEETINGS

- 4.1 Meetings of the Section shall be held regularly. The dates of which such meetings are held shall be selected by the Executive Committee. The Annual Meeting to conclude the season's business and elect new officers is to be held on a convenient day in the spring of each year.
- 4.2 The rules of order shall be those outlined by Roberts insofar as they do not conflict with any provision of the Institute's Constitution, By-Laws or these By-Laws.

ARTICLE 5 - ELECTIONS

- 5.1 Nominations for the officers to be elected shall be made by the Nominating Committee and mailed by the Secretary to the membership at least 11 weeks before the Annual Meeting will be held and shall include an invitation for nominations by members of the Section at Large. Such nominations must be made in writing and must be signed by ten Fellows, Senior Members or Members and shall reach the Nominating Committee not later than 4 weeks before the day on which the Annual Meeting will be held.
- 5.2 The Nominating Committee shall prepare a ballot which shall contain the names of all candidates nominated by it and by others. This complete ballot must be in the hands of the Secretary not later than 3 weeks before the day on which the Annual Meeting will be held.
- 5.3 The Secretary shall mail to the Section Membership the ballot as received from the Nominating Committee not later than 2 weeks before the day on which the Annual Meeting will be held. Nominees of the Nominating Committee shall be identified as such on the ballot. Section Members shall complete ballots so that same will reach the Secretary not later than three days before the Annual Meeting.
- 5.4 When a letter ballot is required the Chairman of the Nominating Committee shall appoint a Tellers Committee, the members of which shall not include any nominee for office in the election. It shall be the duty of this committee to count the votes and report the results of the count to the Nominating Chairman before the start of the Annual Meeting.
- 5.5 Each nomination shall have the written consent of the Nominee. No other nominations will be accepted.
- 5.6 If there should be one Nominee only for each office a letter ballot may be dispensed with, notwithstanding the provisions of this Article and Article I.2.

ARTICLE 6 - GENERAL

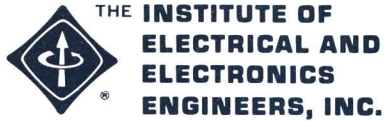
- 6.1 Ten percent (10%) of the voting members, but in no case less than 15 members, shall constitute a quorum at any meeting at which a vote is required.
- 6.2 The Chairman shall be the official delegate of the Section to any meeting at which general Section business is the prime purpose of the meeting. In the event of the Chairman's absence or inability to attend, his place shall be filled by an alternate delegate designated by the Executive Committee.
- 6.3 The fiscal year of the Section shall terminate April 30th.

Any assistance you can give us will be greatly appreciated.

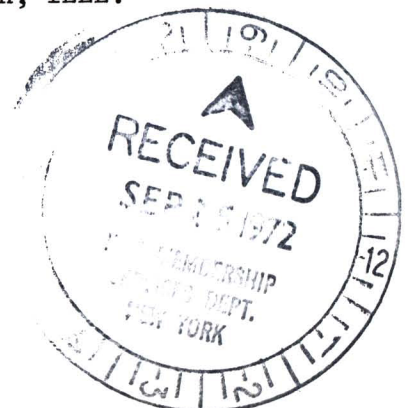

I trust that you will hear shortly from Mr. Lloyd and Mr. Pounsett and that you will be able to present our Petition to the Executive Committee for approval.

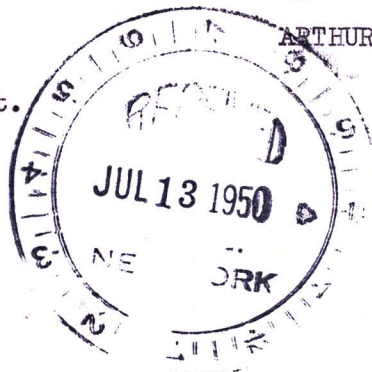

I am very glad to see that the Vancouver Section have submitted their petition and that they will probably be accepted before very long.

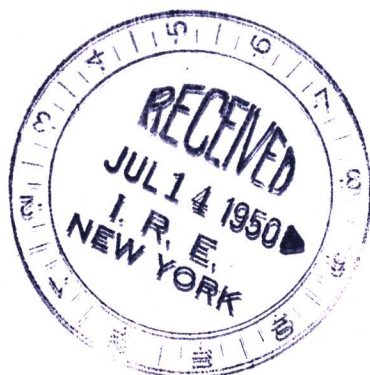
