

Dear Sir :-

I have the honor of notifying you that the Board of Directors of this Institute, at its meeting held on October 9, 1914, authorized the organization of a Section in Rochester, New York, to be known as the ROCHESTER SECTION OF THE AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS. This action was taken in response to the petition forwarded by you to this office, and upon the approval of the Sections Committee.

A call should now be issued to the petitioners and any others who may be interested for a meeting for the election of officers. These are usually an Executive Committee, a Chairman, and a Secretary-Treasurer, but other officers may be elected if it is deemed desirable. A committee should be appointed at this meeting to draft a simple form of by-laws providing for meetings, the election of officers, and the government of the Section.

Each Section is entitled to a certain amount of financial support from the Institute, the amount depending upon the number of members within its territory. For the purpose of determining the number of members the territory of the Sections is limited to points within 60 miles of the meeting place. (See Section 51 of the Institute By-laws).

The appropriation of Institute funds for the meeting expenses of the Sections is made up as follows:

- a. One hundred dollars for each Section, independently of the number of members in that Section.
- b. One dollar and a quarter for each Institute member who shall reside within the territory of each Section at the beginning of the administrative year, namely, August 1.

A form is provided for rendering the monthly accounts of the Local Secretary. The expense of social features must be paid for from local funds.

You will note by referring to Section 70 of the Constitution that each Section is entitled to representation at the Institute's Annual Convention by an official delegate who shall be the chairman of the Section, or, in his absence or inability to attend, by an alternate delegate previously selected by the Section. The transportation expenses of this delegate are borne by the Institute. The Annual Convention is usually held during the last week in June, and the location of our convention for 1915 has not yet been decided upon.

The Local Secretary is expected to make a report of all Section meetings to this office, and from this report a brief notice is prepared for publication in the Institute Proceedings, thus insuring a permanent record of all meetings, and at the same time giving proper publicity to the Section. A report form is provided for this purpose.

Further particulars regarding the routine work and other details of management are given in our annual circular letter to Section officers, a copy of which is enclosed.

Kindly send us a report of the preliminary meeting, with the names of the officers elected, as soon as convenient.

We enclose herewith a copy of the Constitution and By-laws. A supply of expense vouchers, application forms, report forms, and return envelopes are being forwarded to you separately.

BY-LAWS OF THE ROCHESTER SECTION AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS

MAME

Sec. 1. This organization shall be known as the Rochester Section of the American Institute of Electrical Engineers.

MEMBERSHIP

- Sec. 2. All Fellows, Members and Associates of the Institute, residing within the territory of the Section, shall be entitled to membership and to all the privileges of the Section, including the right to vote and to hold office.
- Sec. 3. Non-members of the Institute may become Local Members of the section under conditions prescribed by the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 4. Such Local Members shall be entitled to all of the privileges of the Section excepting the right to vote and to hold office. Local Members shall not be entitled to receive Institute publications.
- Sec. 5. Application for Local Membership shall be made in a form prescribed by the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 6. Enrolled Students of the Institute shall be entitled to the privileges of receiving notices of, and attending meetings, but they shall not have the right to vote or to hold office. Such student shall be required to enroll with the Section's Secretary in order to be placed on the mailing list.

OFFICERS

- Sec. 7. The officers of the Section shall be a Chairman, a Secretary-Treasurer, and an Executive Committee, all of whom shall hold office for one year beginning on August first, with the exception of the Chairman, who at the expiration of the term for which he is elected shall, as Junior Past-Chairman, be a member, ex-officio, of the Executive Committee for the following year. All officers shall be eligible for re-election. They must be Fellows, Members or Associates of the Institute.
- Sec. 8. The Executive Committee shall consist of the Chairman, the Secretary, the Junior Past-Chairman (ex-officio) and four additional members. The Chairman and the Secretary of the Section shall occupy the same offices in the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 9. The Chairman shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Section, under the Executive Committee. He shall preside at meetings, and shall perform such other duties and have such other powers as may be provided for in these by-laws, or as may be delegated to him by the vote of the Section. In his absence his duties may be performed by any other member of the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 10. The Executive Committee shall be the governing body of the Section, and shall direct the management of its affairs. It shall meet at such times as may be found necessary. Meetings may be called at any time upon the request of the Chairman or of three members of the Committee.

- Sec. 11. The Secretary shall perform the duties usually devolving upon the office of Secretary of an organization. In addition, he shall report to the Secretary of the Institute the proceedings at all meetings, within a reasonable time after each meeting. He shall also act as the Treasurer of the Section, and shall render monthly to the Secretary of the Institute an account of such expenses as are chargeable to the Institute treasury. He may have such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 12. Any vacancy occurring during the year shall be filled by the Executive Committee for the remainder of the unexpired term.

ELECTION of OFFICERS

Sec. 13. Officers shall be elected separately by the ballot of the members present at the Annual Meeting.

MEETINGS

- Sec. 14. Unless otherwise ordered by the Executive Committee, meetings shall be held monthly from October to June; time of the meeting to be the fourth Friday of the month.
- Sec. 15. Special meetings may be called at any time by the Executive Committee upon written notice thereof being sent out in advance of the meeting.
- Sec. 16. The Annual Meeting shall be held during the month of May. At this meeting the officers for the ensuing year shall be elected, and such other business transacted as should properly come before the Annual Meeting or as the Executive Committee may refer to it.

- Sec. 17. Reports of Officers.

COMMITTEES

- Sec. 18.

 The Chairman shall appoint such standing and special committees as may be considered desirable, subject to the approval of the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 19. The terms of all committees shall coincide with those of the Section officers.

DUES

- Sec. 20. Institute members shall be exempt from the payment of local dues.
- Sec. 21. The annual dues for Local Members shall be \$2.00, payable in advance.
- Sec. 22. Local Members in arrears for dues for two months shall be suspended or dropped as delinquent.

PAPERS

Sec. 23. The Section shall assist in maintaining at Institute headquarters a reference file of the papers presented at meetings

of the Section, and to this end the Section Secretary shall forward to the Secretary of the Institute the manuscripts of such papers, whenever available.

GENERAL

- Sec. 24. Five per cent, but in no case less than ten of the voting members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at all meetings. A quorum may be waived, however, at meetings where the proceedings do not require a vote to be taken.
- Sec. 25. A majority shall constitute a quorum at all committee meetings.
- Sec. 26. The Chairman in office at the time the Annual Convention of the Institute is held shall be the official delegate of the Section to the convention held during his term of office. In the event of the Chairman's absence or inability to attend, his place shall be filled by an alternate delegate previously designated by the vote of the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 27. Resignations of Local Members shall be taken care of in such manner as may be prescribed by the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 28. Any Local Member may be expelled for cause by the unanimous vote of the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 29. The expense of social features shall be paid for from local funds raised through subscription or otherwise, such expenses not being chargeable to the Institute.
- Sec. 30. In order to provide for the proper handling of the Section's routine work and the management of its affairs the Executive Committee may adopt in connection with these by-laws such rules

and regulations as may be found necessary, but no rule or regulation shall be adopted which will conflict with these by-laws or with the Constitution and By-laws of the Institute.

AMENDMENTS

Sec. 31. These by-laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present at any meeting, provided that notice of the proposed meeting has been sent to all members of the Section at least one week in advance of the meeting, and further provided that the proposed amendment or amendments have received the approval of the Institute's Sections Committee in advance of their submission to the membership.
