

Dear Mr. Fink,

On behalf of all our section members, I would like to thank the Board of Directors, through your conduct, for IEBB's valuable contribution to the First Pan American Congress of -- Electrical and Mechanical Engineers.

We were extremely pleased with the visit of Messrs. Shepherd and Wischemeyer. They did a wonderful job as representatives of IEBB. Professor Wischemeyer's speech in Spanish at the closing ceremony of the Congress caused a wonderful impression. Dr. Shepherd, on the other hand, was elected vice-president of the Congress and, amongst other things, was asked to form part of the reception committee which attended to the President of Mexico during the inauguration ceremony.

On the whole we are quite pleased with the results of the -- Congress. Thirteen countries were represented and 125 papers were presented. At the industrial exposition which was held at the same time as the Congress, 250 exhibitors showed the advances of Mexican industry. A large number of field trips and excursions were also organized.

I am sending you with this letter some of the daily news -- bulletin that were issued during the Congress which will -- give you a fairly good idea of its development. As they are in Spanish I may just point out some of the most interesting contents :

- Complete list of attendants : Bulletin No. 5
- List of papers presented : " No. 2
- Executive Committee : " No. 3
- List of Excursions : " No. 4
- Inauguration Ceremony : " No. 3

Should you be interested in any of the technical papers for publication in the IEEB magazines, I will appreciate your - selecting the names from the list on bulletin No. 2.

During their visit to Mexico, Messrs. Shepherd and Wischemeyer also had the opportunity of speaking with many engineers from the Latin American Sections of IEEB and of learning of our problems. I may, very briefly summarize some of these problems :

1) Application for Membership in IEEB

Although all the engineers interested in becoming members of IEEB can read English, many of them cannot write it. - They find it difficult, therefore, to submit a written -- application in English. Also the engineers that are called to give references might have the same problem and may -- not reply to New York giving the requested references.

Many applicants also find it hard or at least very bother some to obtain from a bank a money order in dollars. The whole problem could be greatly simplified if the local -- section could make the selection of applicants and could -- collect from them their inscription fees in the local cu -- rrency, sending to headquarters only a list of the applicants that had qualified for membership, together with a money -- order covering the inscription fees of all the group.

2) International News

Although IEEB is now supposed to be a non-national organiz ation offering the advantage of reporting technical news - from all countries, we still find Spectrum to be a very -- American magazine of very little practical interest to us. We would appreciate it more if it contained news from all the IEEB Sections throughout the world and if the "People"

section were also more international. We also find - its articles to be too specialized and, whereas we feel that Transactions papers should be of a highly technical and specialized nature, we think Spectrum papers should give more of a general idea of what is going on in the world of electrical engineering.

To this respect we would be only too glad to send you a monthly news bulletin of IBBE activities in Mexico and - I am sure other foreign sections would gladly do the -- same.

### 3) Regional Divisions

Just as in a factory it would be illogical to combine the Legal and the Production departments just because the -- Legal department may not have sufficient personnel to -- have its own independent status, also in an International organization it appears illogical that Latin American should have to report through Japan because we don't have sufficient members. Our membership would increase, if we had a Regional organization through which we could have a -- greater interchange of correspondence, of visits, of information, etc. We therefore once more suggest the creation -- of a Latin American District or Region. I may clarify -- that this does not mean that we don't appreciate the great job that Mr. Omi of Tokyo is doing as Regional Director.

Thanking you again for your interest in our activities and for having arranged for Messrs. Shepherd and Wischmeyer to visit -- us in Mexico, I remain,




Dear Sr. Ulloa:
