1. Professor **Adam Karol SMOLIŃSKI**, 85, Life Fellow 0883512, died on February 29th, 1996.

He was founder of the IEEE Poland Section in 1972, was its first Chairman in the years 1972 - 1979, all the time was a member of Section's Executive Committee, until his last days serving as Chairman of Section's Award Committee. He was the only IEEE Fellow residing in Poland.

2. Professor **Andrzej J. SOWIŃSKI**, 73, Senior Member 6534234, died on April 14th, 1996.

He was the next Chairman of our Section, after Professor Smoliński, in the years 1979 - 1983. Then he was a member of Section's Executive Committee responsible for cooperation with national Association of Polish Electrical Engineers (SEP), Chairman of the Warsaw COM-19 Chapter.

Not surprisingly, Prof. Filipkowski (Poland Section Chair) has not been able to make any headway based on our (Terry's) September 24, 1991 reply to his request for assistance in opening a U.S. \$ account in Warsaw.

Although he agrees that our response was eminently logical, it simply is impossible to do in Poland. Regardless of what we believe, the Polish Government considers the Section an agency of a foreign organization. Therefore, they cannot open their own account.

Prof. Filipkowski has tried to get the Section established as a recognized Polish entity. For their purposes, the Polish government will not accept our bylaws as written. To the extent that the bylaws would need to be rewritten, they would not be acceptable to IEEE. His legal counsel told him to forget it!

Until now the SEP has handled the Section's banking transactions. However, SEP refuses to complicate matters for themselves by accepting dues in local currency and transferring all of it to us here in the States in US\$.

Prof. Filipkowski expects that the Polish banking regulations will not change for at least another two years. However, it seems that a new opportunity has presented itself.

As you will see from the attached, "City Bank" (which I assume is Citibank) has opened an office in Warsaw. Although he did not receive overwhelming support from the local branch, it would at least seem reasonable that we investigate with Citibank in the States whether an account could be opened here which could be used for US\$ transactions from there. If the bank agrees, an account could be set up to eliminate the Polish government red tape, while leaving us with some degree of control (e.g., no credit privileges on the account, etc.)

I am leaving on vacation tonight, but look forward to discussing with you at the beginning of next year.

Dear Mrs Ettinger,

I understand that the establishing of our bank account in Warsaw is a difficult problem. Now I propose to try a different approach. The City Bank has opened its office in Warsaw. I talked to them, but they point out similar difficulties as the Polish PKO bank. But I think that the City Bank managers in New York could be more flexible. Maybe it is possible to create an IEEE account at City Bank in New York with the possibility of orders done by authorized Poland Section officers at the Warsaw City Bank office. Such a solution would be much easier and could avoid lengthy procedure involving the Polish Consulate.

I apologize for making you troubles again, I hope that one telephone call will clarify if this possibility is to be used.




Dear Mr. Filipkowski:

Dear Mr. Czamarski:

I was delighted to receive your letter of October 6 and to learn of the excellent progress being made in the formation of an IEEE Section in Poland.

The nineteen applications to which you refer were not enclosed with your letter. I would appreciate your cabling Mr. Charles F. Stewart at IEEE Headquarters as to whether these applications were airmailed to us separately since we are most anxious to have them processed as expeditiously as possible this year so that the applicants will have the benefit of the lower dues rate in effect this year (\$25.00) rather than the higher rate charged on applications processed as of January 1, 1973 (\$30.00).

It is my understanding that your letter of October 6 constitutes a petition, requesting approval to establish the IEEE Poland Section, and I am therefore proceeding with the formality of obtaining the approvals which the Institute requires in accordance with its Bylaws.

During our visit in Warsaw we discussed the possibility of providing samples of IEEE publications. Paul E. Green subsequently mailed to M. Sc. T. Podgurski on August 30 two packing boxes containing an accumulation of these journals. Mr. Green agreed to continue mailing these publications on an interim basis to the end of this year. I hope that this fairly good sampling of the IEEE journals published over a three-month period will be an indication to your colleagues of the wide scope of our publication program and serve as a basis for the Central Library of the Polish Central Technical Organization in Warsaw to determine which IEEE publications it wishes to purchase on a continuing basis. A summary list of the IEEE publications is included with this letter.



Sending the above application to you I would like to apologize you for such a long preparation period caused by necessity of performing of much work during vacations time.





about the following subjects:

1. Proposed Polish Section of IEEE

The plan that NOT has for starting a Polish Section of the IEEE is to
1) procure hard currency funds for the membership dues of the appropriate
25 individuals, 2) formally apply for IEEE memberships (Academy President
Groszkowski, Professor Smolinsky, and 4-5 others are already members)
and 3) at the same time for the establishment of the Section. Covering
letters attesting to the bona fides of the 25 people will be supplied.
This plan has been presented to the Ministry of Communications which has
approved of it, and in turn has been told by the Ministry of Fiscal Affairs
that their approval of the expenditure may be expected by July. If all goes
well with this, Paul Jespers may expect to receive shortly thereafter a
proposal from them listing the 25 members and designating Mr. Taddeus
Podgorski (Chairman, Committee for Standardization and Measurement) as
the Section Chairman, probably with Badzmirowski and Jarominek as other
officers.

2. Publications Services

When asked what they expected to get out of their IEEE relationship, they answered that publications were their main interest. Barrow explained to them the numerous charges that an IEEE member can be subjected to beyond the \$25 annual membership dues. We explained the page charge system to them but pointed out that these charges were voluntary. Green offered to send them a copy of all IEEE publications for their library (he receives these as a member of the Publications Board).

3. Annual Exchange of Delegations

They will notify us of Polish meetings that may be of interest to IEEE members (an example is attached). This should be pinned down formally by the ISRC Subcommittee after the new Section is established. We should list these in our Calendar of Meetings. Similarly, Jack Kinn should probably routinely send them an invitation each year to our Intercon over the signature of the Chairman of the ISRC Subcommittee on Cultural and Scientific Exchanges.

They would like to receive our Calendar of Meetings as quickly as possible. Can we make an arrangement to send them this material in advance of its appearance in the Spectrum?

4. Meetings in Poland sponsored by the Polish Section

If plans for the section go through as hoped, Badzmirowski will shortly thereafter be in touch with Green and Jespers about Section sponsorship of a Symposium in some area of particular interest to the Poles. Pazdral has suggested that Public Law 840 money (zlotys that have been paid the U.S. by Poland in exchange for wheat) could be used for local expenses if a suitable proposal were prepared by the Polish Section, submitted to NSF (Dr. Elias Schatzman), and accepted.

5. Special Joint Projects

The possibility of joint technical study projects in particular areas of Polish interest was not carried beyond the point where it was left during Harold Chestnut's visit in February. It seems to me a strong initiative ought to exist on the Polish side in order for this to be a success. I suggest that once the Section is set up this matter should be raised again. Perhaps TAB could help identify particular U. S. groups that would like to work with the appropriate Polish groups. P. L. 840 money might be available.

This memorandum summarizes the results of conversations that Paul Green and I had with Dr. K. Badzmiowski and Mr. J. Czamarski and which I had with Mr. N. Pazdral and a financial advisor at the American Embassy in Warsaw, concerning the financial implications of establishing an IEEE section in Poland.

Blocked Currency Accounts

Although I was informed by various Polish trade missions outside the United States that it would be possible for the IEEE to have an international local currency account with the Bank Handlowy in Warsaw, I learned upon arrival in that city that a blocked currency account in Poland is much more restricted than I had imagined.

For example, the money in such an account could not in general be used to cover the expenses of an IEEE Director traveling in Poland; it could not have been used by Paul Green and myself for our hotel expenses; it could not be used for any purchase of international air travel, either by a Polish citizen or by another IEEE member, whether the Polish National Airlines (LOT) or another airlines is used. Note that even a citizen of Poland has to use hard currency in order to buy an international travel ticket (Warsaw to Geneva, for example).

Currency in such an account could be used to buy tickets for travel entirely within Poland. It could be used for printing a conference proceedings, for translation, for rental of a hall, and for other similar uses directly related to a conference, for example. Possibly it might be used to pay the expenses for a technical lecturer who is coming in for a strictly scientific purpose. My impression is, however, that such a use might require expense approval in each individual case.

Blocked U. S. Funds

In your conversation with Pazdral, and again when I spoke to him, he mentioned some interest in using some

of the blocked funds which the United States holds in Poland to hold conferences in Warsaw. Although this is not strictly a matter of Section financing, some comments may be in order. I think this would be a very good program for the IEEE to support, principally by lending its weight to applications to the National Science Foundation for our support of conferences that are organized by the leaders of the Polish Section. Even though these funds are blocked as indicated above, some considerable local use could be made of them. However, the restrictions that apply to blocked accounts in Poland seem too tight for the use of general IEEE funds.

Discussions with Czamarski

During a subsequent meeting with Czamarski, I laid out the rough cash flow for a beginning section of IEEE in Poland. I pointed out that our dues were being increased, and that many members might very well wish to avail themselves of the opportunity to join Groups and to buy additional IEEE publications, so that 25 members would generate an input to IEEE of something above \$1,000. However, some of the money would come back immediately in local currency (approximately \$300 to the section). In addition, there would be perhaps \$200 or so paid to cover travel expenses of a Section representative to the Regional Committee meeting.


Czamarski pointed out that he expected to get the approval of the Finance Minister to convert Polish currency into dollars and that thus the problem would be solved. He thought that the information that I had provided would help him in getting this approval from the Finance Ministry. However, he seems to have no interest whatever in having us operate our own local currency account in Poland.

Recommendations

- 1) We should make no further efforts to establish a local currency account in Poland at this time.
- 2) We should work as closely as possible with Badzmiowski and the group he represents, helping them to organize a section with approximately 25 members as they have discussed.

- 3) In the long run, we should make sure that Polish engineers have reasonable freedom to join (as opposed to having NOT select our members), and that our members are not prevented by currency conversion problems from joining Groups or taking advantage of other IEEE services.
- 4) We should proceed to establish local currency accounts in Yugoslavia, Egypt, and other countries where our members have currency problems.
- 5) We should then look at the currency situation in Poland after another two years or so of experience.
