

Dear Dick:

I have completed negotiations with each of the twenty-one Sections of IEEE in Region IV and believe that all of the requirements for Executive Committee approval of their nerger have been met. I request that the Executive Committee approve these mergers at their August Meeting in San Francisco.

Attachment #1 is a list of the official section name for each of the twenty-one sections and, in addition, a list of the officers and their addresses for each of these sections. All sections agree to the boundaries shown in attachment #2. This map was previously furnished to National Headquarters on March 7, 1963, and has not been changed. Also forwarded is a copy of a form which I requested that each of the sections complete. You will note this form contains the information mentioned in the previous paragraph, as well as information on their By-laws, financial status, affiliations, and the signatures of the Officers involved in the merger agreement. We did not receive By-laws from all of the sections, and it is my understanding that they have six months after the action by the Executive Committee in which to prepare these By-laws for approval. I announced at the Toronto Region IV Meeting that a new constitution for sections would soon be mailed to them and suggested that they adopt this constitution verbatim and compose very simple By-laws to complement it, with a view toward expanding these By-laws as new needs evolve. I am sure that some of the sections have not submitted their By-laws because they have not received the latest edition of the Section Constitution.

I find that the problem of mailing lists for each of the merged sections is still of major proportions. The names and boundaries of our sections have been known by Headquarters since March, and I urge you to do everything that you can to get these lists in order so that the business of our sections can be properly conducted. I recognize that this

is a large problem but it is basic to all of our operations.

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


