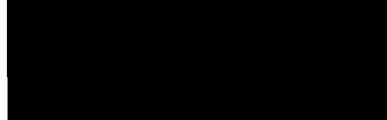

If approved, we agree to abide by the IEEE Constitution, Bylaws and published interpretations of policy.

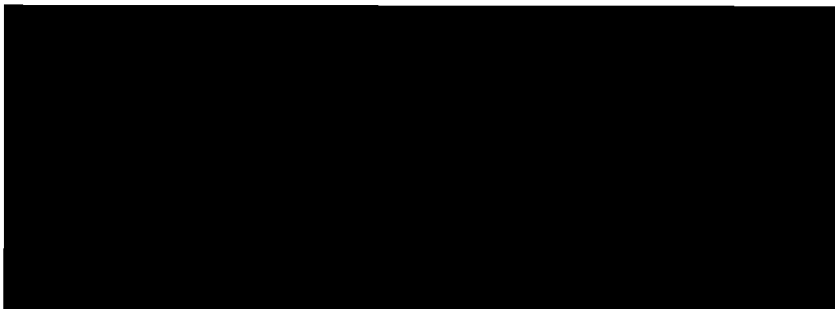

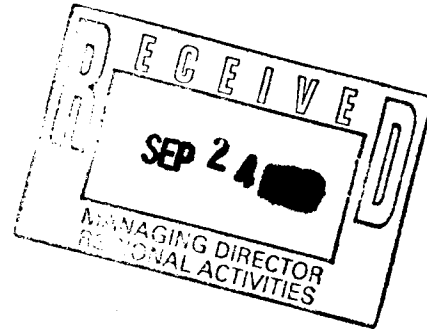

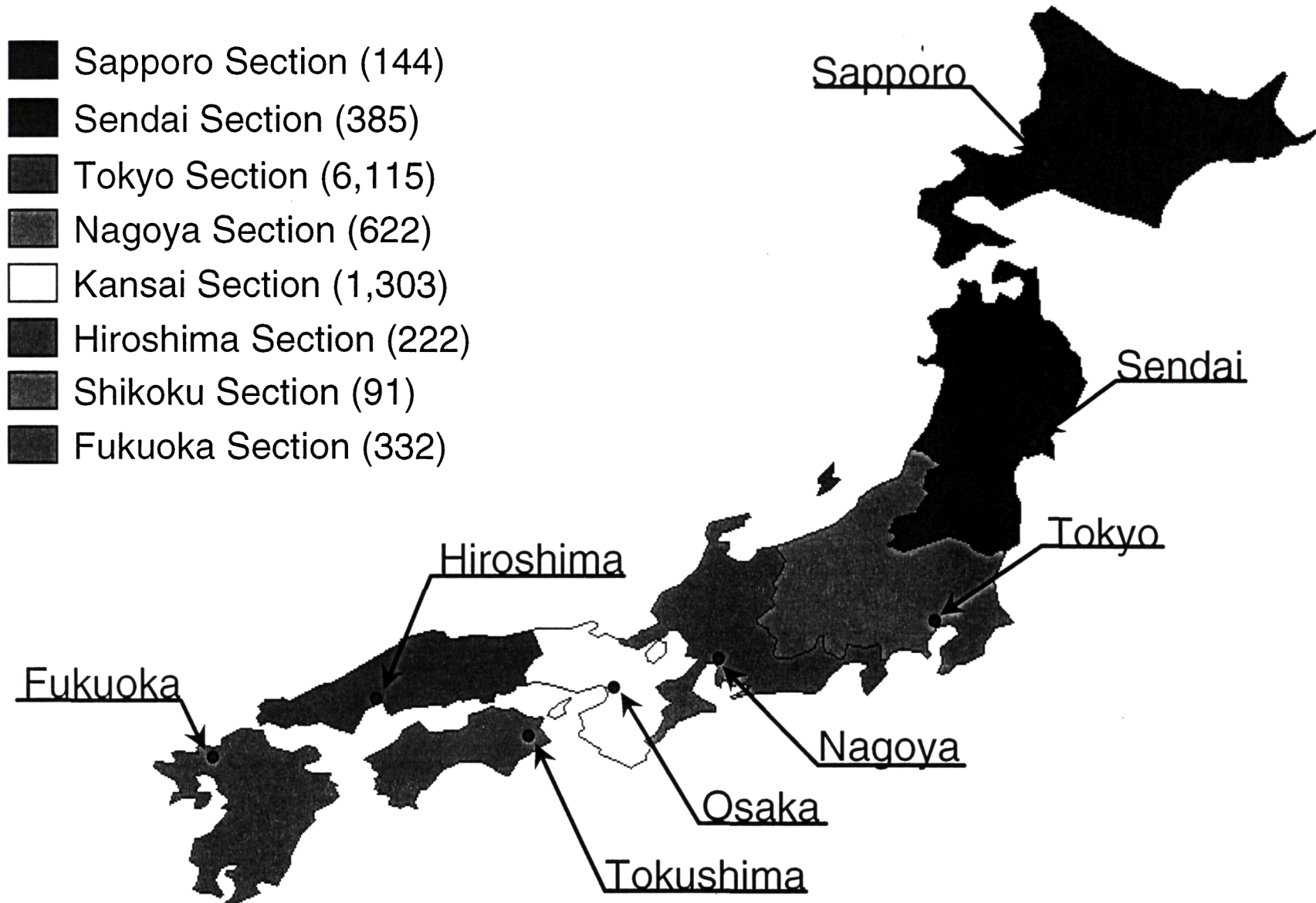
