There are approximately 1950 members located within a radius of 60 miles of New York City. This includes New York, Connecticut and New Jersey and where the territory in the State of New Jersey conflicts with the Philadelphia Section, it has been divided evenly between the two cities,--all towns east of the dividing line going to the New York Section. This assignment of territory is an arbitrary one, and may have to be adjusted later.
