## EXTRACT FROM THE CONSTITUTION.

### ARTICLE IX.

#### INSTITUTE SECTIONS AND BRANCHES.

54. Whenever, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, a sufficient number of Members and Associates shall petition, in writing, these members may form, subject to the Constitution and all By-laws and regulations which may be hereafter prescribed by the Board of Directors, a Section organization for the purpose of more effectually carrying out the aims of the INSTITUTE.

#### EXTRACTS FROM THE BY-LAWS.

SEC. 58. A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed by not less than 25 members residing within the territorial limits hereinafter prescribed. The Board of Directors may decline to authorize the formation of a Section when in its judgment such an organization would not be compatible with the interests of the INSTITUTE.

SEC. 59. In the initial Section organization only petitioners shall have the right to vote.

SEC. 63. The territory of a Section shall include the locality naturally tributary thereto, but shall not include territory so remote or inaccessible that members cannot readily attend meetings. For the purpose of determining the maximum amount to which a Section is entitled under these By-laws, points more than sixty miles from the regular meeting place of the Section shall not be considered a part of that Section, except that, when special conditions warrant such action, additional territory within a reasonable distance may be authorized by the Board of Directors, upon application of the Executive Committee of the Section concerned, and the approval of the Sections and Finance Committees. If adjacent Sections are so situated that the sixty-mile limit embraces common territory, the question as to which Section may claim such members as reside within this common territory shall be decided by agreement between the Sections concerned.

SEC. 64. In addition to INSTITUTE members the section by-laws may admit other persons interested in engineering, who shall have all the Section privileges except those of voting and holding office.

Dividing the membership located in the conflicting territory of the Philadelphia Section and the proposed Lehigh Valley Section, on the basis of the plan proposed to the officials of both Sections, the Philadelphia Section will concede to the Lehigh Section 83 members located in the counties of Berks, Lehigh and Northampton. On August first the Philadelphia Section had a total of 655 members.

In the territory which we have suggested for the Lehigh Section they will receive credit for 130 members 83 of whom will be transferred from the Philadelphia Section as mentioned above and the balance representing those who have not been assigned to any Section previously.

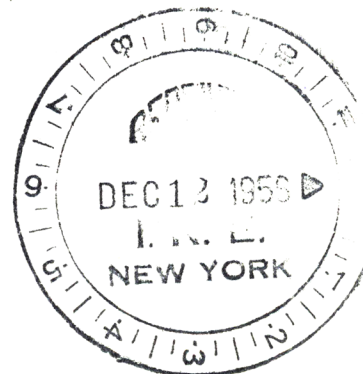

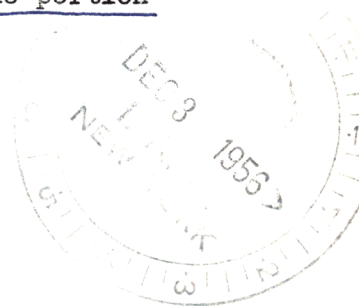

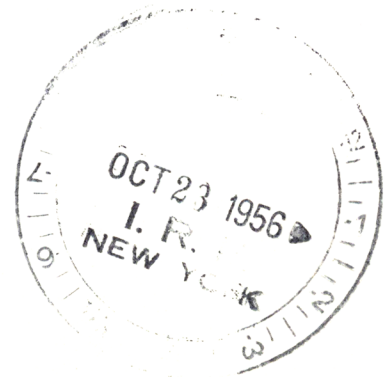

MINUTES OF JOINT ANNUAL MEETING  
LEHIGH VALLEY SECTION-AIEE, LEHIGH VALLEY SUBSECTION-IRE  
AND READING SUBSECTION-IRE  
HELD ON MAY 10, 1963  
GENETTI'S MOTEL & RESTAURANT  
HAZLETON, PA.

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- I - Purpose of Meeting - To approve IEEE-Lehigh Valley Section Bylaws and to elect 1963-64 officers for IEEE-Lehigh Valley Section.
- II - AIEE Chairman G. E. May called the meeting to order at 7:55 PM and stated the purpose of the meeting. Chairman May briefly reviewed the activities and work performed towards the AIEE-IRE merger in our area, starting with the January 16, 1963 meeting of the three Chairmen, one AIEE and two IRE. He noted that the nominations for officers and the IEEE Bylaws had been brought to the attention of all AIEE and IRE Members via our Newsletter and that no petition nominees had been received.
- III - Chairman May called for a vote on the proposed IEEE Bylaws. Some discussion ensued relating to suggested revisions to the Bylaws before adoption. It was pointed out that Article IV of the proposed Bylaws provides ample opportunity for Section Members or the Executive Committee to revise the Bylaws as needed.
1. A motion was made by W. F. Dunkle, seconded by R. Egge, as follows:

Approve proposed IEEE Bylaws for the Lehigh Valley Section as temporary with the provision that all Members could suggest changes in writing to the Executive Committee by July 15 for their consideration prior to their next succeeding meeting. All IEEE Members of Lehigh Valley Section to be duly notified of this action.

Vote: 15 For, 25 Against - Motion defeated.
  2. Another motion was made by P. Sonntag, seconded by J. Pecsek, as follows:

Approve the proposed IEEE Bylaws for the Lehigh Valley Section in their present form.

Vote: Passed by clear majority of voice vote.
- IV - Chairman May called for a vote on the officer nominations as a group to take office on June 1, 1963 as officers of the new IEEE-Lehigh Valley Section.

Chairman - W. I. Huyett  
Vice Chairman - H. A. Tooker

Secretary - C. D. Repp  
Treasurer - S. J. Litrides

Vote: Passed by unanimous voice vote.

V - Chairman May then adjourned the annual business meeting.

VI - Chairman-elect Huyett thanked the Members for their vote of confidence and stated that the new committee selections should be completed by the June 10, 1963 Executive Committee meeting.
