Since our February phone conversation I have not heard from you on the above mentioned subject, nor have you bothered to answer my letter (March 6/87).

I strongly feel the present situation is detrimental to our members' involvement in local activities and is depriving some of the members of the services/assistance they are entitled to.

Therefore, I contacted Canada Post Corporation and using their «Mail Preparation Guide» [from the National Distribution Guide] I drew-up the attached list of Area-Codes for Montréal, Québec, St-Maurice and Ottawa (Québec part only) Sections.

The Canadian Postal Code is composed of six characters, both letters and numbers, in the form of ANA NAN, where A represents a letter of the alphabet and N is a number.

The first three characters, called the Area-Code, describe an area roughly the size of 25 letter carrier routes. The last three characters denote a small and easily-defined section within the area described by the Area-Code.

We expect to see some positive action on this matter at least this time. -

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

Dear Mr. Henline:

Referring to yours of December 9 to all members of the Sections Committee I wish to advise that I have heard favorably from practically all of them in regard to the formation of the Montreal Section. It can therefore be considered as having the Sections Committee's approval. Will you kindly prepare the proper type of recommendation for presentation to the Board at its next meeting.

In this connection I have had some correspondence with Vice-President Price and Dr. Thomson prior to yours of December 9 discussing the Canadian situation as a whole and the ultimate arrangements that they thought were desirable. If the Province of Quebec is assigned to Montreal it would then leave about 24 members in the Maritime Provinces unassigned to any Section. The question I raised with Mr. Price was the desirability of assigning the Maritime Provinces to the Montreal Section at the time it was organized in order to gain their assistance in looking after these members. I presume in view of your letter that Mr. Price does not think this is desirable as apparently they are thinking of the Province of Quebec with the possibility of Ontario later as the proper territory for the Montreal Section.

I think the views of Mr. Price and Dr. Thomson should prevail. If between now and the time the Montreal recommendation is made to the Board they should indicate that they thought it desirable to add the Maritime Provinces to the Montreal Section's territory I would suggest that the recommendation be shaped up accordingly; otherwise, confining it to the Province of Quebec as indicated in your letter of December 9.

PLEASE READ EXTRACTS FROM A. I. E. E. CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS ON BACK OF THIS SHEET.

#### EXTRACT FROM THE CONSTITUTION

#### ARTICLE IX.

#### INSTITUTE SECTIONS AND BRANCHES

54. Whenever, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, a sufficient number of Fellows, Members and Associates shall petition, in writing, these members may form, subject to the Constitution and all By-laws and regulations which may be hereafter prescribed by the Board of Directors, a Section organization for the purpose of more effectually carrying out the aims of the Institute.

#### EXTRACTS FROM THE BY-LAWS

SEC. 36. A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed by not less than 25 members residing within the territorial limits hereinafter prescribed. The Board of Directors may decline to authorize the formation of a Section when in its judgment such an organization would not be compatible with the interests of the Institute.

SEC. 37. In the initial Section organization only petitioners shall have the right to vote.

SEC. 41. The territory of a Section shall include the locality naturally tributary thereto, but shall not include territory so remote or inaccessible that members cannot readily attend meetings. For the purpose of determining the maximum amount to which a Section is entitled under these By-laws, points more than sixty miles from the regular meeting place of the Section shall not be considered a part of that Section, except that, when special conditions warrant such action, additional territory within a reasonable distance may be authorized by the Board of Directors, upon approval of the Sections and Finance Committees. If adjacent Sections are so situated that the sixty-mile limit embraces common territory, the question as to which Section may claim such members as reside within this common territory shall if possible be decided by agreement between the Sections concerned, otherwise by the Sections Committee.

Sec. 42. In addition to Institute members the Section bylaws may admit other persons interested in engineering, who shall have all the Section privileges except those of voting and holding office.





It is suggested that more than the specified amount of names and signatures be included to assure that all petitioners qualify, thus speeding the processing of the petition.

- The name and address of the Chapter organizer


